Superb Sauvignon Blanc from the Languedoc. It is light and crisp, ideal on its own or with food. | £25.50 |

| | | This fruit driven Shiraz is full of concentrated plums and blackcurrants. A hint of white pepper adds a warming spice to the finish. | |

| | | Strong varietal character, deep vibrant colour and ripe, juicy fruit. Approachable, easy-drinking Merlot, half the blend is aged in oak to give added complexity. | |
